Example: Grower purchased 1,000 acres of Enlist One and 500 acres of Enlist Duo. Grower also purchases 500 acres of LeadOff, 2,000 acres of EverpreX, and 300 acres of Brake. Earnings are as follows:

Enlist herbicides: \$2.50/ac x 1,500 ac

= \$3,750

Leadoff: \$0.75/ac x 500 ac = \$375 EverpreX: \$1.00/ac x 1,500 ac (maxed out at 1,500 acres corresponding to Enlist herbicide acres) = \$1,500

**Brake:** \$1.00/ac x 300 ac = \$300

Total earnings = \$5,925



### **Minimum Terms and Conditions for Rebate:**

The rebate for an eligible grower or farm entity shall be paid based on GPOS data, matching acres of Enlist herbicides sold to acres of eligible Corteva Agriscience™ brand soybean herbicides. Acres shall be calculated by the use rates in the tables on this document.

- Earnings under this program must reach or exceed \$250 to qualify for a payment.
- 2. Eligible crop protection products will only be considered for rebate calculations if reported via electronic data exchange (EDI) or grower point of sale (GPOS) via Data Dimensions from crop protection manufacturers' authorized dealers and invoiced between October 1, 2019 and September 30, 2020. Corteva Agriscience reserves the right to refuse rebate payments on product that is not purchased directly from authorized dealers or retailers.
- Rebate payment will only be made on final net units that are used on the grower's owned or rented acres.
- 4. Rebate payment will be in the form of a single-party check payable to the party named on the invoice.
- Corteva Agriscience reserves the right to refuse rebate payments under this program if qualified grower receives payment for eligible crop

- protection product purchases under another program.
- Corteva Agriscience reserves the right to modify or terminate the program at any time without notice to program participants.
- Participation by growers in the program is voluntary and is not required in order to purchase any products participating in this program.
- 8. Qualifying Geography: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri bootheel (including counties of Bollinger, Butler, Cape Girardeau, Carter, Dunklin, Iron, Madison, Mississippi, New Madrid, Oregon, Pemiscot, Perry, Reynolds, Ripley, St Francois, St Genevieve, Scott, Shannon, Stoddard, and Wayne), New Mexico, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, and West Virginia.
- Retailers must report EDI/POS by October 15, 2020 in ordered to be considered for this program.
